Message from Headteacher

Dear parents and carers,

Earlier this week the government announced its proposal to introduce a phased return to school of pupils – starting with Reception, Year 1 and Year 6 from **June 1** at the earliest. This is in addition to children of key workers and our vulnerable pupils, who are already attending. The government wants to introduce a phased return in a way that is “measured, reduces risks, is guided by science,” and only if it meets their “5 key tests,” including evidence that the rate of infection is decreasing.

In response, and to be prepared, we are planning how we might do it in a way that puts **pupil and staff safety first**.

To help us in our planning, it would be useful to have an indication of how you are thinking at the moment so we will be sending a survey for parents in Reception, Year 1 and Year 6 to complete (we will send this by text). We would be grateful if you could respond to the questions by Tuesday 19 May.
