SATs are national assessments for children at the end of **Key Stage 2 (Years 3, 4, 5 and 6)**

All children in Year 6 take the SATs.

Designed to measure their attainment in **English and Maths.**

Scores are **shared with their secondary schools.**

Attendance and preparation are essential for success.

SATs Schedule 2026

Base Line Assessment

Base Line assessment and first Mock SATs have taken place.

SATs Preparation Meeting

The SATs Preparation Meeting will outline the process, expectations, and how parents can support their children during this important academic year.

Mock SATs

Mock SATs will be **conducted in December, February, and April** to familiarise students with the exam format and timing, ensuring they feel prepared and confident.

SATs Testing Period

The official SATs Testing Period is scheduled for May 2026, where students will take national assessments in English and Maths, crucial for their academic journey.

Results Release

Results Release will occur in July, providing parents and students with the outcomes of the SATs, helping to set the stage for future learning and development.

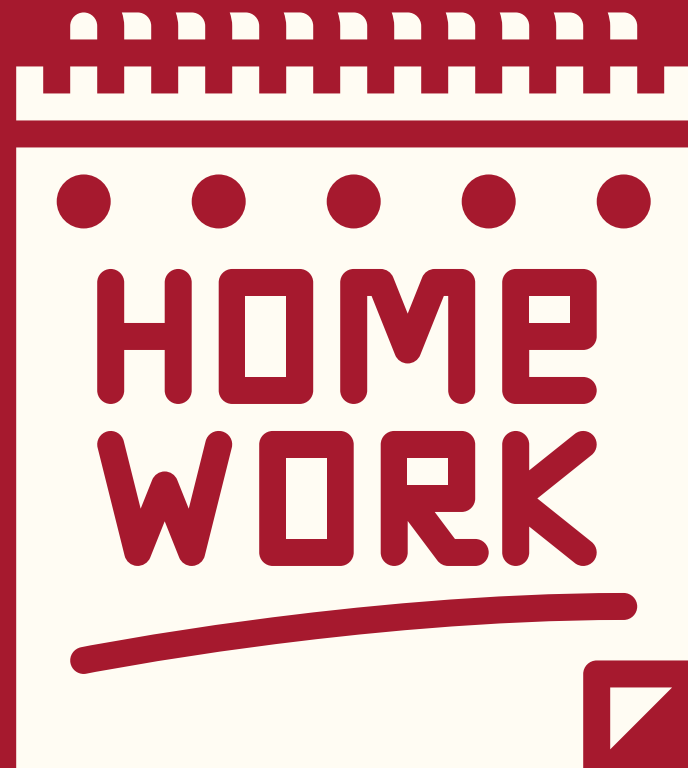
