Dear Parents,

As you know, all children in Reception, Year 1 and Year 2 are entitled to a free school meal under the Government’s Universal Infant Free School Meals scheme.

We are just writing to remind you that as your child will be in Year 3 in September they will no longer be eligible to have a free school meal under this scheme. However, depending upon your income, they may still be entitled to receive a free school meal and the school will be entitled to additional funds for your child known as Pupil Premium.

In order for your child to be eligible for a free school meal, you should be in receipt of one of the following benefits:

- Universal credit with an annual income of no more than £7,400
- Income Support
- Income Based Jobseeker’s Allowance
- Income-related Employment and Support Allowance
- Support under Part V1 of the Immigration and Asylum Act 1999
- The Guaranteed element of State Pension Credit
- Child Tax Credit (with no Working Tax Credit) and an annual gross income of no more than £16,190

Even if you choose not to take up the free school meals option, the school can still receive this funding to enhance your child’s education. We can check this if you complete the Free School Meals/Pupil Premium Application Form attached and provide the Council with your National insurance number, date of birth and postcode on the form. It will be used only for this purpose. Please return to this form to the Gate Office by **5 July 2019**.

The cost of a school meal is £2.52 payable on ParentPay; if you have not set up a ParentPay account please go to the school office.
