This half term, year 4 will begin a topic on Relationships, Sex and Education (RSE) in combination with the Science curriculum and Personal, Social and Health Education curriculum.

As stated in our RSE policy, which is available for viewing on the school's website, we believe teaching SRE is very important because:

- It is a body of knowledge essential to children's wellbeing and understanding of self and relationships.
- It provides children with access to correct information about their bodies.
- It develops children's vocabulary for communicating about themselves and their bodies.
